Camping guidelines give councils the authority to allow Cub Scout packs to conduct a pack campout (overnight) activity, as long as the activity is conducted at a council-approved location and is under the direction of a leader trained to do so. Adults giving leadership to a pack overnigher *must* complete Basic Adult Leader Outdoor Orientation (BALOO) training.

The target participant for BALOO training is a Cub Scout leader with a desire to plan and carry out an entry-level outdoor experience for the pack. Successful completion of this training will help the leader properly understand the importance of program intent, youth protection guidelines, health and safety, site selection, age-appropriate activities and sufficient adult participation.
